Christ in the Passover Saturday, April 13—6:30 PM

Sahar Sadlovsky was raised in a traditional Jewish family in Tel Aviv, Israel. He had a very low view of God until some Christian Arab friends introduced him to Jesus. He gave his life to Christ and is now a full-time missionary with *Jews for Jesus* residing in Israel.



Sahar will present "Christ in the Passover" showing the link between the ancient Festival of Redemption and Christ as the Lamb of God. During this presentation, we will see a table set with traditional Passover items. The missionary uses Scripture as well as the visual items to walk through a Jewish Passover seder, weaving the story of the Exodus together with the life, death and resurrection of Christ. The words He spoke in the upper room come alive as each Hebraic item is carefully explained.

The “Good News”

Whose voice have you been listening to? God’s voice (through His Word)? The voices of your friends, your enemies, the world, Satan? Did you base your “identity” on what God said or what all the other “voices” had to say? The news this week reported that most people are basing their identity on what others say about them (via Facebook, etc.).

God’s “good news” to me this last week (via Titus 2:14) was that “Jesus was crucified to redeem me and that He purchased my freedom from all wickedness.” Now, that’s good news! I’m free from that “old way” of living! But, another day I read in Hebrews 4:2 that when some people heard the good news of deliverance from all bondage, it didn’t benefit them because it was not mixed with faith by those who heard it! Oh, no! How sad! They could have been delivered from every kind of bondage...set free...but they didn’t believe what God said! Do you believe what God says, or are you still going by what you feel?
