Bible Book of the Month

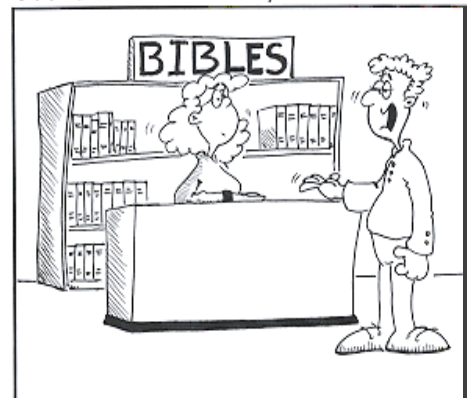

Does your day-to-day life mirror the beliefs you hold, or do you find yourself in a constant battle with hypocrisy? Take heed of the doctrine you find within the pages of Romans, but don't forget to put it into practice as well."

With 16 chapters in Romans, consider reading the same chapter two days in a row. However you decide to do it, I hope you gain better understanding and a fresh love for the Word!

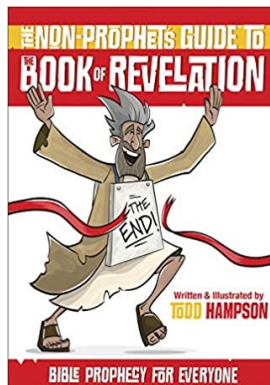
New Tuesday Bible Study to Begin
