Mike Bartel to Share About Human Trafficking

Michael Bartel, of F.R.E.E. International, will be sharing at New Life Fellowship on Sunday, Oct. 18 about his ministry to "Find, Restore, Embrace, and Empower victims of human trafficking.

For many Americans who hear the words "human trafficking", they think that it's a problem that takes place overseas in some far off country. They couldn't be more wrong.

F.R.E.E. International was founded in 2007 by Michael and Denise Bartel because they believed then, and still do, that every man, woman and child should be FREE from slavery!

The Bartels worked with Project Rescue out of Southern Asia to combat human trafficking and realized the issue was not just a foreign problem. Upon their return to the U.S., they founded F.R.E.E. International and continued the fight against modern day slavery here in the States.

F.R.E.E. began with headquarters in New York City and worked.. throughout the country to raise awareness about human trafficking by training local communities how to mobilize and be effective in fighting slavery.

Now headquartered in Las Vegas, there are F.R.E.E. team members who work across the U.S. with local law enforcement, churches, schools, and local and state governments. One of their core beliefs is that they are most effective in the fight when the strengths of others are brought to the table and coordinated effectively.

October Bible Book of the Month... Second Peter

Peter's theme in his second letter is a simple one: pursue spiritual maturity through the Word of God as a remedy for false teaching (2 Peter 1:3, 16). When false teachers begin to whisper their sweet words into the ears of immature Christians, the body of Christ begins to break apart. Peter repeatedly points to the Word of God as the primary means of growth for the Christian (1:4, 19–21; 3:1–2, 14–16).

Peter encouraged his readers to apply themselves to acquiring the true knowledge of God and living out the life of faith with "all diligence," so that they may "be found by [Jesus] in peace, spotless and blameless" (1:5; 3:14). And if believers did not follow his advice, they would be giving their Christian community over to the heretics, people who look to "exploit... with false words" (2:3). www.insight.org
