## GOOD FRIDAY SERVICE/SEDER MEAL Mar. 29—7:00 PM



We're trying something a little different this year for our Good Friday service. We'll be participating in a Christian Seder Meal. God told the Jewish people always to celebrate the Passover meal beginning with the night they were set free from slavery in Egypt. The Passover meal was also the Last Supper that Jesus ate with his disciples the night before his crucifixion.

Such a meal reminds us of when Jesus will come back and take Christians to heaven with Him. The Bible says He is going to have a feast called the "Marriage Supper of the Lamb (Rev. 19:9). Christians are the Bride of Christ, so this will be the grandest celebration of all when we are joined to our Bridegroom in heaven!

The Seder is more than just a meal. The word "Seder" means "order." Thus the Seder is a very orderly, structured event complete with readings, prayers, and songs as well as specific foods prepared in specific ways.

The words and rituals of the Seder are a primary vehicle for the transmission of the Jewish faith from grandparent/parent to child, i.e., from one generation to the next.

In the same spirit, we as Christians want to deliberately pass our faith from one generation to the next according to Psalms 145:4, "Let each generation tell its children of your mighty acts." Celebrating the Christian Seder Meal is one excellent way to do this.

We will remember the freedom the Jewish people experienced as they were set free from slavery in Egypt 4,000 years ago, but at the same time, the freedom that we experience as born again followers of Christ who has set us free from the slavery of sin and death.

Considering inviting the grandparents of your children to join us in experiencing this wonderful event.

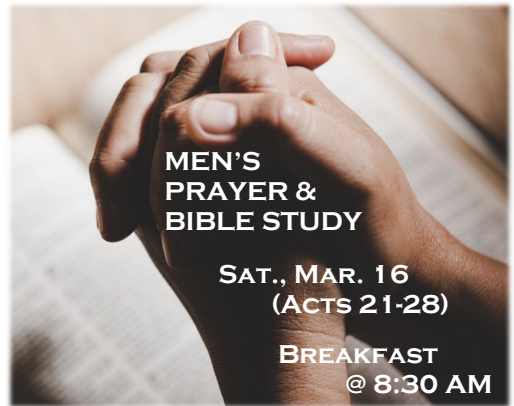
